An earlier communication of Hall's presented to the Royal Medical Society of England in 1833 should also be mentioned. Though the work of these men was conducted independently, they arrived at the same general conclusions and established definitely that the sympathetic plexus is connected with the posterior column of the cord and that the motor impulses pass from the anterior roots. Three other important contributions should be mentioned before taking up the work of Westphal and Erb. George Morton, of Philadelphia, published a research in nerve physiology in 1839, entitled *Grania Americanae*. The work of Magendie Floures on the relation of the brain and medulla oblongata to the functions of the cord, and that of H. H. Smith, are to be mentioned in connection with the development of our knowledge of the various reflexes. Since Westphal and Erb recognized the values and introduced studies on the...
